

Forklift Truck Experienced Operator Training (All Truck Groupings)

This Course is for people who have been operating forklift trucks in industry and are very competent in its use. An experienced operator course is for people with a minimum of 6 months regular use. but for one reason or another have never had formal training or certification required by legislation, including the Health and Safety at Work act 1974 and are re-enforced under the Provision and Use of Work Equipment regulations 1998. The HSE Approved Code of Practice (ACOP) L117 which deals with forklift training requirements gives guidance of what an employer needs to do minimum to comply with the law.



Theory knowledge taught during this course will be as if the experienced operator is a novice operator, in most cases this is what the experienced operator is lacking. The practical side of training will be slightly scaled down from the full novice training course criteria simply because of the level of confidence and competence already gained, possibly through many years of use and a little bit of luck. By the end of this course the operator will have gained extra vital and essential operating skills recognised to national operating standards, satisfying the legal duties and requirements placed upon employers for purposes of health, safety and welfare, insurance requirements and enabling us accredited training providers to rubber stamp their qualification.



QUALIFIED

All delegates are issued a certificate of training to operate the forklift truck type trained and tested on.

Photo ID cards in addition to a certificate of training can be issued on completion (Please discuss at time of booking, a small additional charge applies for these)

All delegates new qualifications will be added to the ITSSAR Trained Operators Passport Scheme known as TOPs. For further information about TOPs please visit www.itssar.org.uk/tops.aspx

Course ratio & duration 1 to 3 delegates, and is normally as stated below, but this can be slightly less dependent on the experience of the operator (Please discuss at booking so as there is no confusion)

Course Trainee's: **3** = 22.5 hours = 4 Days
