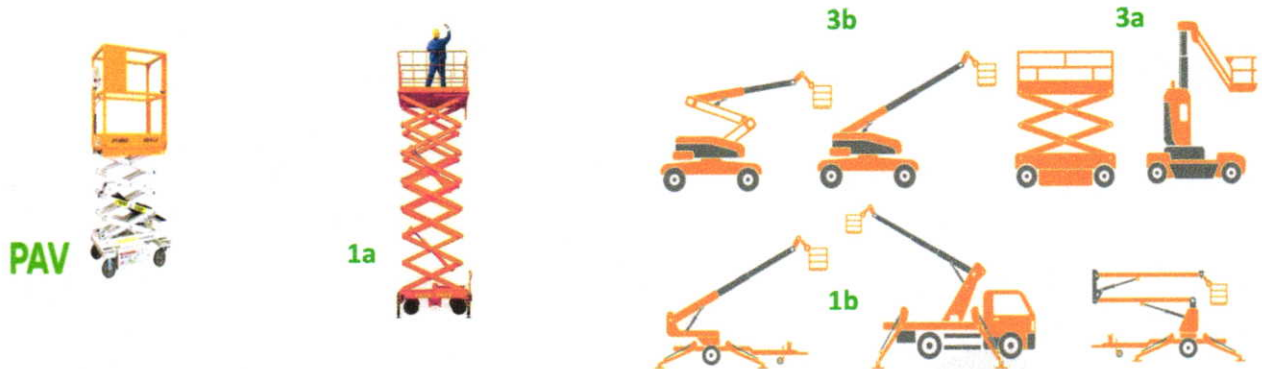

(MEWP) Conversion Operator Training



Duration of Course:

Allowable time **PAV**, 1 x ½ - day. (4 Hours approx.) Maximum number of delegates 6. For operators who do not hold **1a** or **3a** See note below.

Allowable Time **1a**, 1 x 8 -hour day. Maximum number of delegates 4.

Allowable time **3a**, **1b**, 1 x 8-hour day. Maximum number of delegates 3.

Allowable time **3b** 1 x 8-hour day. Maximum number of delegates 3.

NOTE operators who achieve 1a or 3a category are permitted to operate **PAVs** and other forms of **MEWP** on receipt of familiarisation (no further formal training is required).

Description of Course Objectives:

This Conversion operator's course is aimed at individuals who hold a certificate of competence for one type of MEWP but require a certificate to operate another.

Work at height is a high risk activity, even though you already hold a certificate of competence for one MEWP type, you could put yourself or others at great risk if you are not familiar with the controls and capabilities of the MEWP type you require to operate. This course is designed to give candidates both theoretical and practical skills and be assessed and certificated as a competent operator for the new category of MEWP.

Who Should Attend Conversion Training?

Operators needing to hold additional certification to use 1a, 1b, 3a, 3b, or PAV as part of their employment duties,

Delegates Requirements

Candidates will be expected to complete both a written test paper and successfully demonstrate their level of operator skills under test conditions to qualify.

Candidates Must have English language comprehension / physically fit and in good health and agility.

Additional Information:

At the end of the course each candidate receives a BRITTOP operators' certificate of competence, and an optional photographic operators' card if required.



Training Requirements

A room must be provided with electricity for the theory session of the course ,which is suitable for the number of delegates attending.

All equipment to be used for the practical sessions must meet industry standards and be certified as fit for use, MEWP to be LOLER certificated and in date.

Content of Course:

Theory & practical training will be covered for the MEWP type you are converting to. Theory test and practical testing will be conducted to confirm your understanding. (Training subject covered will be relevant to the MEWP were applicable)

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

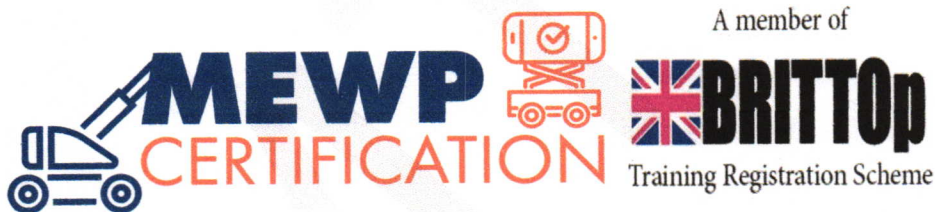
Your current MEWP Certificate you hold must be in-date to be able to do conversion training, if it is not a refresher training course will be needed prior to conversion. Candidates who do not make the standard at test will be given another test if time allows.
